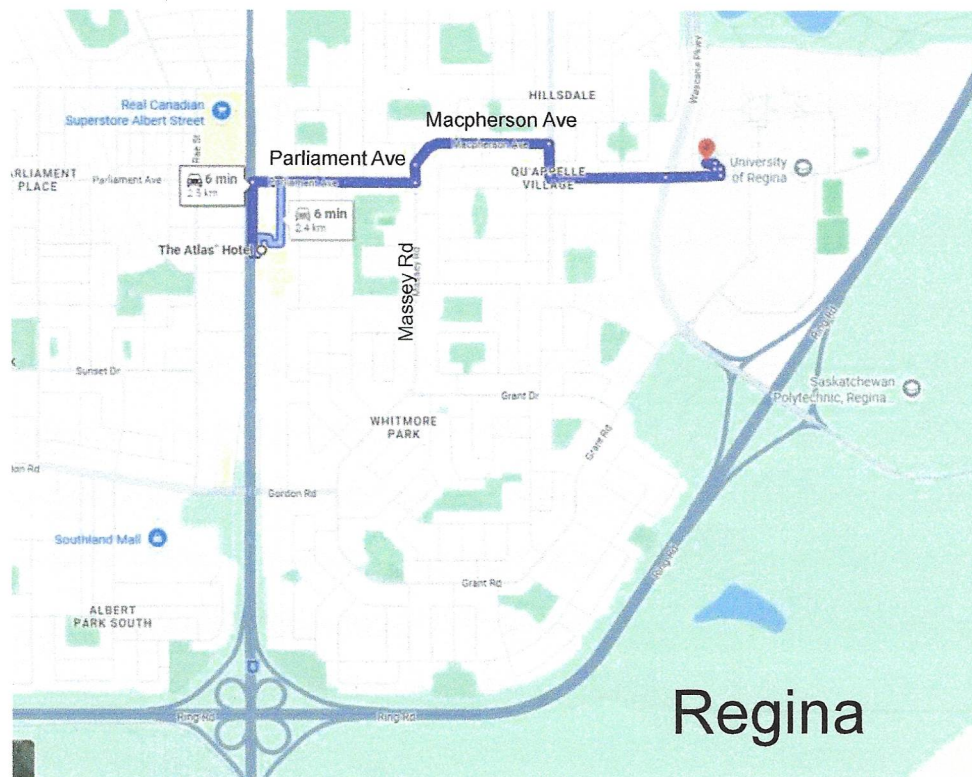

To navigate from the hotel to the University, the hotel is at 4177 Albert Street to the University, Lot 2 3737 Wascana Parkway.



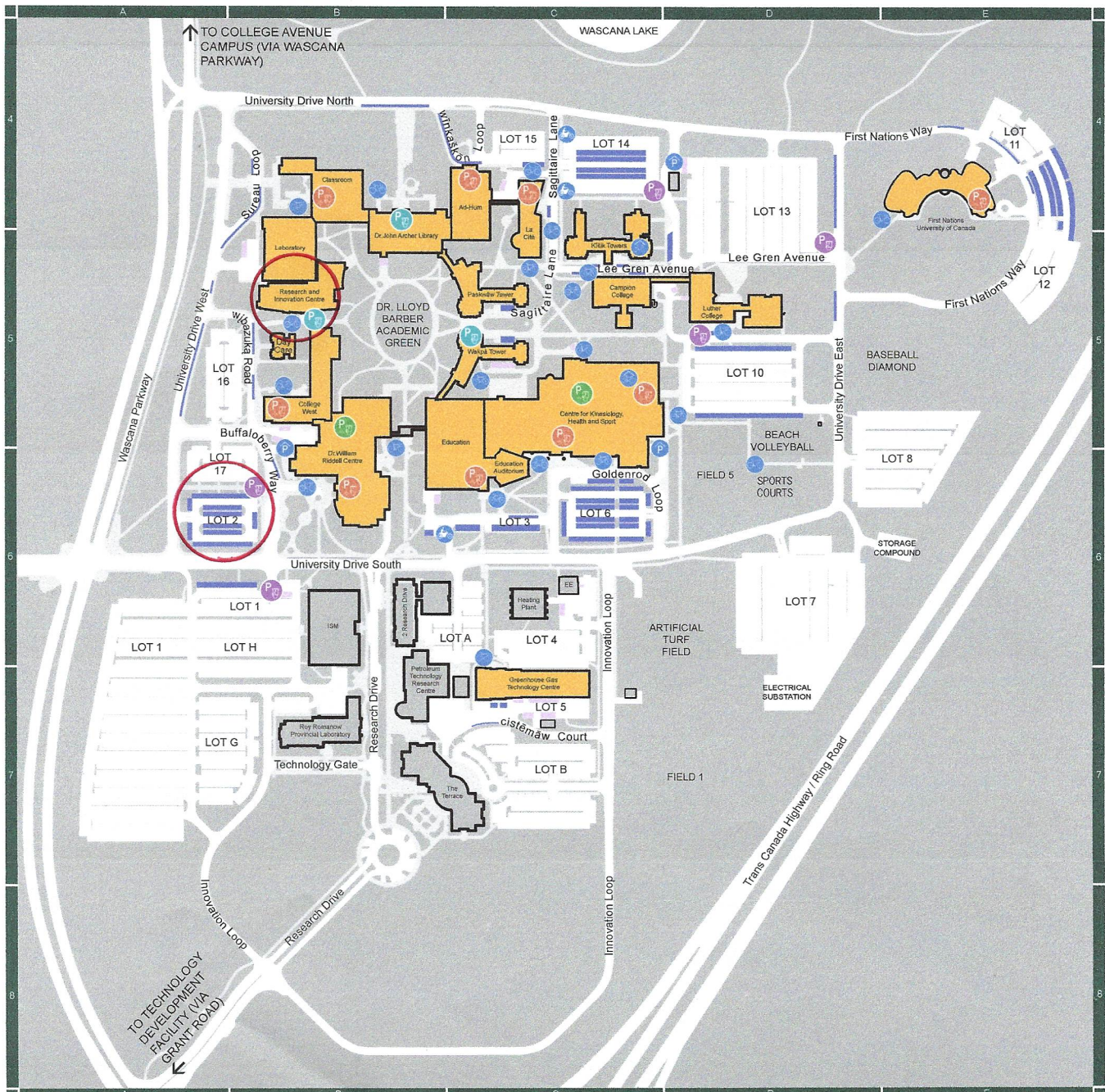
